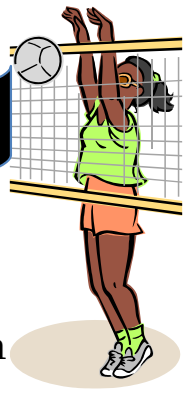

Refunds :According to A.R.S. 15-342(24) and H.B. 2421, "extracurricular activities" means school sponsored activities that require enrolled students to pay a fee in order to participate. If a tax credit receipt is given to the individual by the school finance office for this participation fee, then he/she may claim this paid fee on his/her tax return as a credit to reduce their tax liability. Therefore, the school board approved participation fee paid by the taxpayer will benefit on his/her tax return and may not be refunded by the school.
