- 1 box of crayons (no more than 24 please)
- 2 pocket folders (vinyl/plastic works best)
- 1 pencil box to hold the basics (medium size)
- 2 spiral notebooks (wide-rule 70/100 sheets)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 container of disinfectant wipes
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 ream of white Xerox paper
- 1 small pair of scissors
- 1 package of Ticonderoga pencils, no novelty pencils as they don't sharpen well.
- 2 containers of liquid soap
- 1 set of ear buds for working with the computers (the Dollar store sells these)



Here are some important skills that your incoming second grader should have in August:

Reading: know long/short vowels, ask appropriate questions and answer questions about a text that include who, what, where, why, and how, and be able to recall/retell events from a story.

Math: Add/subtract numbers up to 20, understand the Commutative Property of $9+5=5+9$, tell time to the hour and half-hour, and count to 120.

Writing: Begin a sentence with a capital letter and use the correct end punctuation mark, write independently on a single topic, and write something that either tells a story, provides information, or gives their opinion.

Social Skills: Follows directions and participates in group activities, interacts appropriately with peers, and can work independently for a specific length of time.
